**Title:**

Importance of effective scientific communication

**Abstract:**

Scientists need to communicate their work and results more than ever, not only to other scientists but also to stakeholders and society. However, they do not receive training, and many times they are unaware of the importance of communication or, worse still, they relegate it to a matter of humanities. In this talk I will review the fundamentals of scientific communication, I will differentiate it from other types of communication, and I will propose simple ideas to improve it. I will concentrate on preparing and delivering oral presentations and will only lightly address written documents.

I intend to encourage scientists to work on their communication skills because "communication works for those who work at it" (John Powell) and luckily, it's not that hard!

## EXPOSICIÓN DE PROYECTOS DE TESIS (11:15)

## **PRESENTATION OF THE RESEARCH PLANS (11:15)**

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Those students who have been in the program for more than two years (students from the third year) will present their thesis project. Each one will have 5 minutes (timed) to present 5 slides, following the philosophy of 3 minute PhD context (in a slightly more relaxed way).

The first and second year doctoral students will present the work they have developed up to now in a very reduced way in 2 minutes with 2 transparencies. The goal is for all doctoral students to know in which field the others are working for a possible search for synergies.

Later, there will be a quick round of questions about all the thesis projects presented.
